Bloodborne Pathogens

- · To remove gloves, avoid touching contaminated areas of the glove and wash hands thoroughly with soap and water.
- · When danger of splashing exists, wear a face shield to prevent human bodily uids from getting in your eyes, mouth, or nose.
- Avoid getting human bodily fuids in open sores or wounds.
- If human bodily fuids come in contact with your skin, wash the area immediately with soap and water and rinse.
